

Who's Who

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CHILDREN WILL LEARN ABOUT



The children in the Seahorse Reef will be taught specifically to their needs. Some lessons may be based on their targets from our professionals.

We will be using Direct Phonics for our phonic lessons, Draw Write to start our writing lessons and White Rose for our maths.

The rest of our curriculum coverage will be tailored to the children's interests.

We will also be using Attention Autism, Attention boxes, elements of the EQUALS curriculum and sensory circuits with the children in the Seahorse Reef.

Our teaching is based on 1:1 working with the children as well as facilitating their appropriate interactions with peers.

BEHAVIOUR & ATTENDANCE

- We expect the highest standards of behaviour at all times, parents help is vital to making this work
- Sign up for Class Dojo
- Children must come to school everyday
- Arriving after 8:55 is late

Attendance during one school year	Equals this number of days absent	Which is approximately this many weeks absent	Which means this number of lessons missed
90%	19 days	4 weeks	100 lessons
80%	38 days	8 weeks	200 lessons
70%	57 days	11.5 weeks	290 lessons

PE DAYS



- PE for the Seahorse Reef will take place twice a week on Tuesday and Friday.
- Come dressed and ready, appropriate for the season/weather

READING AT HOME



- Nothing is more important for your children than helping them learn to read
- They should read every single day: with you, to you, to siblings, be read to by you
- Books from school
- Fines for losing/damaging books

HELPING YOUR CHILD AT HOME



- Communication through Class Dojo
- Retrieval Practice
- Knowledge organisers
- Always find time to read

Annual Reviews and Ongoing Work



- Your child will have either an EHCP or an SSPP and will be working with professionals who will see them in school and may wish to speak to you at home. This will be communicated to you in advance where possible.
- Your child's plan will be reviewed annually to look at their progress and see if further steps need to be taken (moving from SSPP to EHCP)
- We will let you know if our professionals (Speech and Language Therapist, Educational Psychologist, Communication and Autism worker, Pupil and Schools Support) have seen your child and any feedback they have given
- It is also important that any letters or advice given to you from outside professionals are communicated with school. We can take copies of any letters needed.

GETTING IN TOUCH

- Make an appointment to see teachers via the school office for anything else
